



# EDKPA Draw



## Terms and Rules of the EDKPA Monthly Lottery

1. The EDKPA have been issued with a Small Societies Lottery licence and the Monthly Draw/Lottery will be conducted in accordance with the Small Societies Lottery legislation as specified in the 2005 Gambling Act.
2. The Promoter of the Monthly Lottery is Mr D.O'Sullivan, Appletree Cottage, Huntworth Lane, Nth Petherton Somerset TA7 ODU.
3. The object of the Lottery is to raise funds to assist in the running of (EDKPA). Approximately half of the money raised by the Lottery annually will be put to this use and the other half will be returned in cash prizes. Each participant must be over the age of 18 years.
4. Subscription to the Lottery will cost £12 per year per subscription, payable by cash or cheque (made payable to Exeter District Kidney Patients Association), participants may have more than one subscription. This will be required as a "one-off" annual payment of £12 per subscription..
5. Each subscription will be allocated a roll number and a record of these against participants' details will be maintained electronically. Personal details held in this way will not be divulged to third parties in accordance with the Data Protection Act. Participants will be notified of their allocated roll number(s).
6. Draws will take place monthly and there will be a first, second and third cash prize. The draws will take place on the second Saturday of the month at the promoter address, commencing in September 2015 using an electronic random number generator.
7. The results of each draw will be published in the EDKPA News sheet and also displayed on a notice board in Sid Ward. Payments are made by cheque and will be mailed to winners.
8. The Lottery will be run on an annual basis but membership can be taken out at any time.
9. Admission to the draw will commence in the month following receipt of the subscription.
10. In the event of any complaint or dispute arising from any of the dealings of the lottery, a small but impartial sub-committee will meet to adjudicate on that complaint. The findings of this committee after due consideration will be final.
11. In the event of the Draw/Lottery ceasing, any subscriptions/chances paid in advance will be refunded on request, otherwise donated to the EDKA & funds.
